

Replacing Default Element Images

In order to replace default element images you need to modify servoy default css. See [Customizing the Web Client](#) for more info. The following examples are css classes that can be added in default css in order to modify default images.

- Replace the calendar field image:

```
.calendar img {
  background: url("http://www.servoy.com/developer/6xx_intro/resources/servoy_donut16x16.ico") repeat scroll 0
0 rgba(0, 0, 0, 0);
  height: 0;
  padding: 8px;
  width: 0;
}
```

- Replace accordion open/closed image

```
.ui-state-default .ui-icon {
  background-image: url("http://www.servoy.com/developer/6xx_intro/resources/servoy_donut16x16.ico") !
important;
  background-position: 0 center;
}
.ui-state-default .ui-icon {
  background-image: url("http://www.servoy.com/developer/6xx_intro/resources/servoy_donut16x16.ico") !
important;
  background-position: 0 center;
}
```

- Replace db treeview node image (this can be also done from scripting)

```
.icon-panel img {
  background: url("http://www.servoy.com/developer/6xx_intro/resources/servoy_donut16x16.ico") repeat scroll 0
0 rgba(0, 0, 0, 0);
  height: 0;
  padding: 8px icon-panel !important;
  width: 0;
}
```



Note

The url from css can also be embedded data url, for example:

```
background-image: url(
/fNwfjZ0frl3/zy7///wAAAA
AAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAAACH5BAKAABAALAAAAAAQABAAAVVICS0ZGLCQAosJ6mu7fi
yZeK
qNKToQGDsM8hBADgUXoGAiqhSvp5QAnQKGIgUhwFUYLCVDFCrKUE1lBavAViFIDlTImbKC5Gm2hB0SlBCBMQiB0UjIA7);
```
